The Dutch Healthcare Authority has, in accordance with Chapter 4, paragraphs 4.2 and 4.4, of the Health Care Market Regulation Act (Wmg),

*and more specifically:*

Article 35, Article 50, paragraph 1, parts c and d in conjunction with Articles 51 to 53 of the Wmg,

*as well as the policy rule:*

Dental care policy rule,

*and the arrangement:*

Oral care regulations,

*decided:*

that is legally valid,

*door:*

- healthcare providers who provide dental care as described in or pursuant to the Health Insurance Act (Zvw);

- healthcare providers who provide dental care as described in or pursuant to the Long-term Care Act (Wlz) to patients staying and being treated in a Wlz institution;

- healthcare providers as referred to in Article 1, paragraph 1, section c, under 2°, of the Wmg (factoring companies).

To the extent that no care as described above is involved, this tariff decision applies to actions<sup>1</sup> or activities<sup>2</sup> in the field of dental care provided by or under the responsibility of professionals as referred to in Article 3 or 34 of the Dental Care Act.

Professions in individual health care,

*On:*

all health insurers, healthcare providers, all (non-)insured persons<sup>3</sup> and third parties,

*the performance description and associated maximum rates (in euros):*

as described in Annex 1 and Annex 2 to this performance and tariff decision, may be charged, provided that the conditions, regulations and restrictions described for the performance, as well as the conditions, regulations and restrictions stated in the applicable policy rule and regulation, have been met.<sup>4</sup>

The established maximum rates include VAT costs, but exclude VAT levy and payment by a healthcare provider.

The declarations must be specified in accordance with the descriptions in Appendix 1 and Appendix 2. In the case of cash payment, the final amount may be rounded to the nearest multiple of 5 euro cents.

#### **Expired and withdrawn old performance and tariff decision**

Simultaneously with the entry into force of this performance and tariff decision, the published but not yet effective Performance and tariff decision for dental care, with reference number TB/REG-23606-01, is withdrawn.

The Dental Care Performance and Tariff Decision, with reference number TB/REG-22610-02, which was valid until 31 December 2022, has expired by operation of law with effect from the day after the latter date.

#### **Applicability of prior performance and tariff decision**

The Performance and Tariff Decision for Dental Care, with reference number TB/REG-22610-02, remains applicable to decisions and matters that are based on that performance and tariff decision and that relate to the period for which that performance and tariff decision was in force.

#### **Entry into force**

This Decision shall enter into force on 1 January 2023 and shall expire on 1 January 2024.

In accordance with Article 20, paragraph 2, section b, of the Wmg, notice of the inspection of this decision will be published in the Government Gazette.

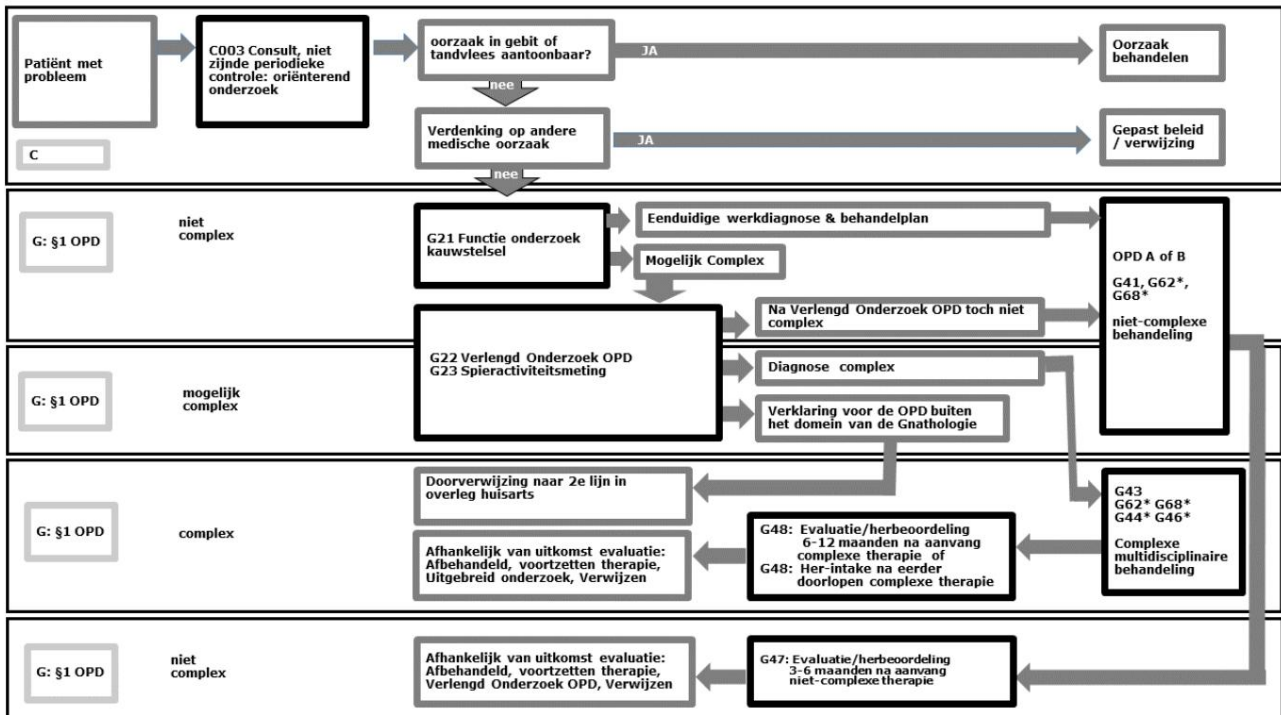

The costs of dental technology that are necessary for the treatment and have been purchased additionally by the healthcare provider and the costs of the materials that can be specifically attributed to the relevant service. This explicitly does not refer to the consumables. For the services for which material and/or technology costs can be charged separately, this is indicated in the current policy rule and tariff decision with one asterisk (\*).

The material and/or technical costs can be charged in accordance with the regulations described in the Dental Care Policy.

If the healthcare provider manufactures the dental technical workpieces itself, it is obliged to specify the technical costs to the patient or his/her insurer in accordance with the provisions of the Policy Rule for dental technology under own management.

For further transparency regulations regarding the specification and disclosure of material and/or technical costs, please refer to the Oral Care Regulations.

### 2. Laboratory costs

The laboratory costs of the external bacteriological laboratory examination that are specifically attributable to the relevant service. For the services to which this may apply, this is indicated in the current policy rule and tariff decision with two asterisks (\*\*).

Laboratory costs may be charged in accordance with the regulations described in the Dental Care Policy.

For further transparency regulations regarding the specification and disclosure of laboratory costs, please refer to the Oral Care Regulations.

### 3. Max-max rates

3.1 The maximum rates in this tariff decision may be increased by a maximum of 10% if this is based on a written agreement between the relevant healthcare provider and health insurer.

3.2 A rate that is not higher than the maximum rates in this tariff decision may be charged to anyone. A rate that is established with application of article 3.1 of appendix 2 of this performance and tariff decision may only be charged to (a) the health insurer with whom the increased maximum rate has been agreed or (b) the insured for whose benefit a health insurance policy with regard to dental care has been taken out with a health insurer with whom such an increased maximum rate has been agreed in writing. A rate that is established with application of article 3.1 of appendix 2 of this performance and tariff decision may only be charged to the extent that a health insurance policy with regard to dental care has been agreed between the health insurer and the insured that includes the relevant service.

3. For the purposes of this performance and tariff decision, a person who:
  - is insured under the social health insurance legislation of another state; and
  - lives in the Netherlands or is temporarily staying here; and
  - is entitled to benefits in accordance with the provisions of or pursuant to the Zvw and the Wlz under a Regulation of the Council of the European Union or under a bilateral or multilateral treaty signed by the Netherlands,equated with a Zvw or Wlz insured person respectively.
4. The material and/or technique costs and laboratory costs must be charged separately. These costs may not be higher than the costs paid and/or owed by the healthcare provider for purchasing (see the provisions on this in the Dental Care Policy Rule).
